School Registration 2020-2021

To register your child in Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools, the online, centralized **registration will begin on January 8, 2020 at 8 a.m.** Pacific Standard Time. The following information will help determine if this process will apply to you.

Take a moment and ask yourself the following questions:

- 1. Is my child new to Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools?
- 2. Do I have a child that will be turning five years old on or before December 31, 2020 that will be entering Kindergarten? Applications must be received by June 15, 2020 to ensure a placement in your child's catchment-area school.
- 3. Do I want to register my child in Late French Immersion?
- 4. Do I want to register my child in Early French Immersion? Applications will be received until January 31, 2020, at which time student selection will be determined by lottery. Parents will be notified in early February 2020. Late French Immersion Students are placed as space permits.
- 5. Do I want to register my child in secondary academies?
